- Annual application is required. Application must be complete with all supporting documents combined as a single PDF document and submitted electronically. Incomplete and/or do not qualify applicants, will be notified by April 15.
- Deadline: Applications must be emailed to scholarship@olcnw.com by **April 1** to be considered for award distribution within the upcoming school year. Confirmation of receipt will be emailed.
