SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The scholarship program of the Olympic Logging Conference Foundation awards scholarships to OLC attendees, children or grandchildren of OLC attendees and children or grandchildren of past Board Chairman for education after high school. Scholarship awards may be used for tuition, books and/or room and board for students attending any college, university or vocational/technical school. A minimum \$500.00 shall be awarded annually and will be paid directly to the recipient's post-secondary institution.

Criteria

- Current OLC attendee, children/grandchildren of current OLC attendee or children/grandchildren of past Board Chairman. Current member is defined by paid membership within the past two years.
- Pursuing post-secondary education
- Application must be completed in full and supporting documents submitted with application.
- Annual application is required.
- Preference may be given to new undergraduates and forestry related fields but not exclusively awarded to such candidates.
- Application must be emailed to **scholarship@olcnw.com** by April 1 to be considered for award distribution within the upcoming school year. Confirmation of receipt will be emailed to applicant.
